It has been a great learning experience the last four years as I taught four batches of students at HTS. The most exciting and thrilling experience for me was to

realize that I need not understand everything in the Bible but first believe what the Book says, as it says it, and then the Lord takes care of helping me to understand. This Bible believing approach sorted out a lot of confusion, doubts and misunderstanding of the scriptures and helped me personally and to teach the students better.

I have also seen that when I just teach and preach from the AV 1611, doubting nothing, the Lord blesses the ministry and souls get saved and the saints are edified. Earlier, I thought that I needed to defend the Book, and the doctrine I believe. Many a times did I have long and heated arguments with those who hated the AV 1611, trying to convince them that this book is indeed the inerrant, inspired words of God, but to no avail. I would often get frustrated and discouraged but the Lord has shown me since that, my job is to preach and teach that Book, not defending it. Like a great man said, you don't have to defend a 500 pound African lion, you just let it loose. Once I got the basics of this doctrine, it became a framework or a world view through which I could understand and discern the truth or falsity of doctrines and teachings which I had learned in college or read in books. This has been the greatest blessing in my life so far, as I have been teaching that Book.

Believing the King James Bible and teaching doctrine from it has cost me a few "friends" and has made me an object of ridicule among some brethren. But I guess it is a very miniscule price to pay compared to the inexplicable blessing of seeing sinners get right with God and saints growing and living as witnesses for Christ as a result of preaching this Book.
